A Few Reminders for our Parents and Dancers

In order for us to ensure a clean and safe environment for our students here at CSDA, we offer these few reminders:

- Please come to the studio door to pick-up your student. We realize the parking lot around the studio can get very busy but we are asking that you do not allow your dancer to walk through the parking lot or meet you at Safeway or another merchant in our center.
- Be sure and wear street shoes - not your dance shoes - outside the studio. There are several reasons for this including your safety, your investment in your dance shoes and our investment in our dance floors!

- All dancers should bring a bottle of water to class in their dance bag. If they forget, water bottles are available for purchase in the office for \$1.
